**GENERAL PROVISIONS:**

The dog show is organized according to the dog show rules of the FCI and ČMKU. and is open to males and females registered in stud books recognized by FCI. Certain dog have to reached the age required for entering the desired class on the show day at the latest. Division into classes is according by the FCI Show Regulation and is described in the registration form. Dogs whose application does not contain the necessary documents (certificate, a copy of the championship) for inclusion in the working class and the winners, the dog will be placed in open class. Organizers are not responsible for damage caused by a dog or exhibitor, or for death or loss of a dog.

Free-roaming dogs are not allowed. Biting dogs have to wear muzzles.

Excluding from the exhibition – females in season, females in the higher stages of pregnancy, nursing females, individuals with operational or other interventions to eliminate defects in the exterior of the dog.

The exhibitors are obliged to abide with the provisions of the FCI Show Regulations, of these propositions and the instructions of the Show Committee, to which they bind themselves by submitting the entry form. They are also obliged to maintain the exhibition area clean. In case

the show does not take place for objective reasons, the fees would be used for covering the show preparation expenses. It is forbidden to bring puppies for the purpose of sale to the show. The organizer does not accept any responsibility for undelivered applications. The exhibitor is obliged to pay the exhibition fees even if they will not take part in the exhibition with a dog.

#### **VETERINARY RULES:**

- All dogs participating must be clinically healthy
- Dogs do not need a certificate of clinical health examination.
- All the time during the dog show the owners must supervise / take care of the dogs so that they do not cause any damage to other dogs or humans.
- All dogs must have a pet passport or certificate of vaccination (according to § 6 paragraph 3, letter b) of the Act 166/1999 Sb., Veterinary care and amending certain related acts, as amended vet. Law). All animals must have a valid vaccination against rabies in accordance with § 4, paragraph 1, letter f) health law and has been since the age of 4 months. Dogs coming from EU Member States and third countries must have a valid EU pet passport and must fulfil the conditions laid down by the EU Regulation 998/2003 of 26.5.2003.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING THE ENTRY FORM:**

Entry forms should be filled out using a typewriter or in block letters. For each dog, a separate entry form should be filled out. Illegible applications will not be accepted. The discount for the second and additional dogs may be applied only if the name of the owner is the same as for the first dog. Any change in the second entry form, e.g. addition of point ownership, will be considered to be a new entry at full cost. The organizer does not accept any responsibility for an incorrectly filled-in entry forms. A copy of the pedigree must be attached to each application form. The entry form must be attached to the proof of payment or accompanied by proof of payment of the transfer from a bank account. A dog can only be entered into one class. Accepting of the entry form will be confirmed by e-mail.

#### **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE SHOW:**

FCI pedigree or studbook confirmation that this pedigree is guaranteed, valid vaccination passport of the dog or its EU Pet passport with valid vaccination.

#### **PROTEST:**

A protest against any decision made by the judge is not admissible. A protest can be submitted for formal reasons such as violation of show regulation provisions and proposition provisions. The protest must be submitted in written form, against a deposit of 2000,- Kč and only until the end of the judging. If the protest is found to be unjustified, this deposit will be forfeited to the organizer of the show.

#### **THE CLASSES REQUIRED BY ČMKU:**

- **Youth class** – 9 - 18 months
- **Intermediate class** – 15 - 24 months is open to all dogs regardless of the tests performed and awards
- **Open class** - from 15 months it is accessible to all dogs regardless of the tests performed and awards
- **Working class** - from 15 months, at international exhibitions accessible only breeds included in the list of breeds that have for the title International Champion pass the required examinations. Fulfilment of the conditions for the working class to the MVP must be documented in the prescribed certificate is valid for sk breeds X. On the other

kinds of exhibitions can be based on the request of the Kennel Club Working class open to other breeds, which exposes the national certificate. Expose the organization charged by ČMKU or directly ČMKU.

- **Champion class** - from 15 months, including international exhibitions can be opened instead of champion class, for dogs with recognized international or national champion title, the title of national champion title and winner of a club special exhibitions. These titles must be obtained in competition with adults.
- **Veteran class** - from 8 years.

**NEXT WILL BE OPEN:**

- **Baby class**- 4 - 6 months
- **Puppy class** - 6 - 9 months
- **Honor class** - from 15 months, it only opens the club, specialty and national shows, for dogs with recognized international, national champion title or title Club Winner, National Winner of special show, with no claim to the CAC. Enters the mark and order. Excellent 1 can not participate in the competition for Best of Breed.

For inclusion in class is crucial age of the dog on the day of the show (the day of the assessment on the show), other conditions must be met on the day of filing. Example: if the dog was born 1st January 2011 is at the exhibition held 1st October 2011 in the class of the youth.

Reassign a dog from one class to the other class at the show is only possible with the written approval of the organizer and is permitted only if there was confusion breed or sex, or that the erroneous inclusion of a dog is caused by the organizer.

**TITLES AND REVERSION:**

**CAJC** - male and female in the youth class awarded excellent 1.

**CAC** - male and female in intermediate class, open, working and winner class - awarded excellent 1.

**Res.CAC** - male and female in intermediate class, open, working and winner class - awarded excellent 2

**KV / Best of Juniors BOJ** - the title obtains the best young male or female awarded CAJC

**Best of Veterans BOV** - the title obtains the best male or female awarded excellent 1 in veteran class.

**Club winner** - winners from the intermediate, open, working and champion classes with CAC.

**Best of Breed** - The Best Youth dog or female (BOJ), Club winner and the best Veterán (BOV). The title may be entered only at shows with the award CAC.

**Winner of the Club show / BIS** - only winners (BOB) of breeds Azawakh and Sloughi.

**COMPETITIONS:**

**Best Couple** – a male and a female presented at the show. Dogs must not be in the ownership of one owner.

**Best Kennel** – minimum 3 individuals and maximum 5 individuals, which have been judged at the show and come from the same kennel and have at least two different fathers or mothers. These individuals may not to be owned by the breeder.

**Child and a dog 3 – 9 years old** - for children 3-9 years old under the Junior Handling rules.
